We'll be taking along a vehicle for some mobile festive fayre in the form of mulled wine and mince pies to help you fend off the chill.

As an alternative, we'll provide a map so that you can take a walk to Nunnington through the woods stopping off for mulled wine and mince pies en route. In either case, you can then choose to take Lunch or Dinner at The Pheasant on Boxing Day, as part of your package.
